Categories to be judged are as follows:

- 2. Drumline
- 3. Drum Major(s)
- 4. Color Guard
- 5. Music
- 6. Best of Show (Highest total of above categories)

REMEMBER, only the top 10 bands will get the incentive, but ALL BANDS are eligible for judging and trophies!

We hope you will join us to perform for our faithful parade-goers and help make this parade a great one! The parade is something everyone looks forward to at the Blueberry Festival and every year I get asked to have more bands, that's where you come in! We can't do it without you!
