RULES & REGULATIONS

All contestants in Marshall County are eligible to participate when meeting the qualifications outlined below: Please keep this sheet for you reference!

- Applicants must be a resident of Marshall County.
- 2. Contestant must be a at least fourteen (14) years of age.
- 3. Applicants will try on the Hank Costume at the interview. Please wear athletic clothing and shoes to try on the suit.
- 4. Applicants must be able to wear the costume in hot and cold weather. There is an ice pack as part of the costume for extremely hot weather. The shifts may be shortened if the weather is unbearably hot.
- 5. Applicants will receive an email with a schedule of times to choose from for their interview.
- 6. The schedule on page 4 includes other Marshall County Parades where Blueberry Hank will be needed. Once Hanks are selected, a schedule will be put together for who will be attending which event. Other events may pop up where Hank will be asked to attend. Hank will ideally have a 2-3 hour shift with 1-2 hour break between shifts.
- 7. Hanks will be chosen based on Interview and Schedule Availability.
- 8. The Hank Committee reserves the right to change the foregoing Rules & Regulations as necessary at any time.
- 9. A completed form must be post marked or delivered to the Blueberry Office by 5:00pm on May 6, 2024.
- 10. If you are Hank, your attendance at the Festival is required **ALL** four days and the parade.

All selected (High School and College aged) Hanks will receive a T-Shirt and other miscellaneous gifts.
